SESSION STREAM

Session met on April 16th. Becky reported that she and John Eckman had completed the presbytery required annual review of the church finances. This is not an audit and not to replace a professional review—it is something that presbytery requires to be done by 2 people in the church and must be done before the Session Records Book can be submitted for review each year.

Stewardship/Finance: Melinda reported that the trustee list has been updated at the bank. Presbyterian Women account monies will be moved to a Designated Fund.

Property/Personnel: Fred reported that the tile work on the courtyard floor has begun. He also asked Becky if she would organize a group to plan for decorating the courtyard area. Sanctuary lighting project is 90% completed.

Congregational Care: Sharon reported for Joyce Johnston that this committee continues to shepherd our sick and home bound members with visits, calls, cards, flowers and gift baskets.

Mission Outreach: Sharon reported that the Blessing Box continues to be successful so we thank everyone who donates to this very worthwhile project which serves our community in need. This committee met on April 2nd and discussed community picnic where it was agreed that we would help with the event but not spearhead it.
